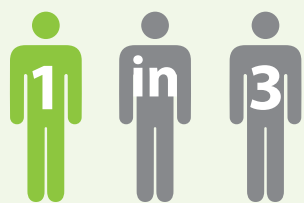


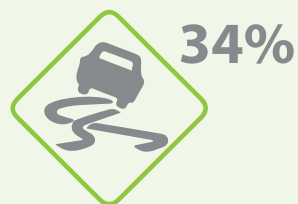
Driving When It Is Raining

To ensure your vehicle is in safe conditions for driving in wet weather



All of your vehicles lights work well

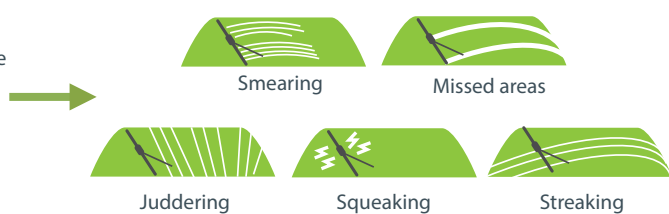


Your windscreen and lights are clean



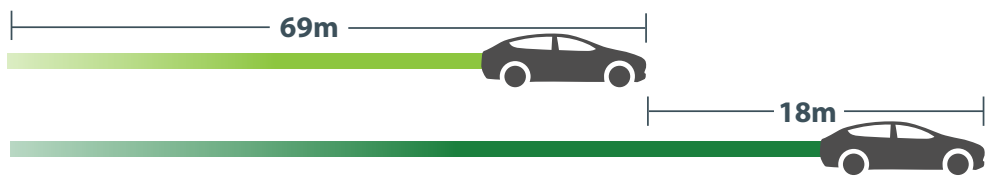
Make sure you have good tyre tread (atleast 1.5mm deep)

Make sure your windscreen wipers are working effectively and get regular maintenance to avoid the following



Braking distance in wet weather

Dry road compared to a wet road with an average tread and a speed of 80km/h. So make sure you slow down in wet conditions.



Increased claim frequency

The higher the rainfall, the more insurance claims occur.^{5,6}
