Adaptation of best practice for Australia

- Mixed response
 - Support for safety
 - Push back long list of objections
 - Takes too much time
- Overseas is not Australia
 - Trams, dog trailers, hook turns, motorbikes filtering etc
 - Needs new content (video)
- On-road
 - Too risky to be on the road
 - Who pays if the driver has a crash
- Drivers
 - Low literacy (can't read/poor comprehension)
 - Don't have access to a computer, can't navigate online training
 - Drivers too fat, too unfit, can't ride a bike

"...drivers smoke a packet of cigarettes and eat twenty five meat pies a day.


